

Poverty and Prayer Presentation

TECHNICAL NEEDS

“Poverty and Prayer” is an **AUDIO/VISUAL** presentation, so it is vital that the film clips Gerry shows be seen and heard well. The following are items that need to be in place and to have been tested before the presentation:

1. DVD player with REMOTE (Gerry or an assistant can skip to chapters on the DVD)*
2. LCD PROJECTOR for the DVD player
3. WHITE SCREEN high enough and large enough for all to see**
4. SOUND system (both for Gerry and DVD player)***
5. MICROPHONE (for speaking segments of the presentation)
6. TECHNICAL ASSISTANT who can work the DVD and sound
7. DARK ROOM (dark enough for viewing films, esp. if the event is during the day)****
8. TABLE to lay out DVD's and San Damiano materials
9. A VOLUNTEER to manage the San Damiano table (selling books & DVD's)

*If a DVD player is not available, a computer will work. But a DVD player is preferable.

**If no screen is available, a very clean white wall might suffice.

***If possible, the audio should be fed into the house audio system; if that is not possible, then a pair of external speakers should be hooked up to the DVD player.

****If the room has windows without curtains, and it is a daytime screening, the windows must be covered in such a way as to prevent daylight from flooding the room.

Allow time for a system check about 2 hours prior to the scheduled speaking time. This might sound a little overkill, but we continue to have experiences where the system is missing something and there is no time to fix things. Gerry's presentations are powerful and meaningful, but they depend on a quality showing of the films. Some schools and parishes are fully technically set-up and others are not, so we are double checking everything to make sure there are no major hang ups. Thank you!
